

Spinney Pre-School Death of a Child on the Pre School Premises Policy

Identifying

- If it is suspected that a child has died in the setting, emergency resuscitation will be given to the child by a qualified Paediatric First Aider until the ambulance arrives. We also have a Defibrillator that we can use. This is stored in our Pre School Staff room.
- Only a medical practitioner can confirm a child has died.

Informing

- The Supervisor ensures emergency services have been contacted, ambulance and police.
- The parents are contacted and asked to come to the setting immediately, informing them that there has
 been an incident involving their child and that an ambulance has been called, asking them to come
 straight to the setting or hospital as appropriate.
- The Supervisor calls the Chairperson and informs them of what has happened.
- The Deputy is delegated to phone all parents to collect their children. The reason given must be agreed by the Supervisor and the information given should be the same to each parent. (on wall in Staff room_/
- The decision on how long the setting will remain closed will be based on police advice.
- Ofsted are informed of the incident by the Chairperson and a RIDDOR report is made.
- Staff will not discuss the death of a child with the press.
- Staff will not discuss the death of a child with other Parents/Carers.

Responding

- The Committee/Trustees/Police will decide how the death is investigated within the organisation after taking advice from relevant agencies.
- The Committee/Trustees will coordinate support for staff and children to ensure their mental health and well-being.
