How the children learn

- Playing and Exploring - **Engagement**
- Active Learning - **Motivation**
- Creating and Thinking Critically - **Thinking**



Talking and Listening

- Talk to your child about the true meaning of Christmas.
- Listen to stories e.g Owl Babies/Christmas.
- Talk to your child about the different types of owls there are.
- Listen to the different sounds birds make.

Out and about

- Visit a Christmas Grotto (if possible)
- Visit Cheshire Falconry at Blakemere (if possible)
- Visit the library to encourage your child to select books both non fiction and fiction, here are a few examples 'The owl and the crow', 'Wow! Said the owl' and 'The Owl who was afraid of the dark'

Songs/Stories/drawings

- Teach your child traditional Christmas Carols.
- Find pictures of owls/Christmas
- Draw pictures of Owls/Christmas
- Read Christmas stories.
